David Henderson, MD is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Family Medicine at the University of Connecticut School of Medicine (UConn SOM). He joined the faculty fulltime in 2003 after a long period as a part time community faculty member. In 2006 he became Clerkship Director of the required 3rd year Family Medicine rotation, and Predoctoral Director in the Department of Family Medicine. Most recently he has been recruited to serve as interim Associate Dean for Student Affairs for the 2008-2009 academic year. His academic committee assignments include serving as chairman of the Public issues council at the UCONN SOM as well as a number of other committees. Nationally, he serves on the program committee of the Society of Teachers of Family Medicine, the leading academic organization in Family Medicine.

Dr, Henderson arrived at UConn SOM with 19 years of clinical experience including many years of private practice; work with underserved populations in community health centers; experience in international medicine having spent one year working in Sierra Leone, West Africa; as well as a stint as a hospitalist. He is a graduate of Amherst College and Southern Illinois University SOM. He completed residency training in Family Medicine in 1984. He remains an active member of many local and national professional societies. He is also active locally working collaboratively with a number of municipal and community-based organizations to forge solutions to the problems of youth violence and lack of access to healthcare experienced by the uninsured.
